

**Hypnotherapy Learning Hub**  
**Code of Conduct for**  
**Soul Regression Therapy Practitioners**

1. The following Code of Conduct is the common sense code of ethical practice for Soul Regression Therapy practitioners and the minimum standard for students and graduates of the Hypnotherapy Learning Hub.

**1.1 Soul Regression Therapists to provide services in safe and ethical manner**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must provide health services in a safe and ethical manner.
2. Without limiting subclause (1), Soul Regression Therapists must comply with the following principles:
  - (a) a Soul Regression Therapist must maintain the necessary competence in his or her field of practice,
  - (b) a Soul Regression Therapist must not provide health care of a type that is outside his or her experience or training,
  - (c) a Soul Regression Therapist must not provide services that he or she is not qualified to provide,
  - (d) a Soul Regression Therapist must not use his or her possession of particular qualifications to mislead or deceive his or her clients as to his or her competence in his or her field of practice or ability to provide treatment,
  - (e) a Soul Regression Therapist must prescribe only treatments or appliances that serve the needs of the client,
  - (f) a Soul Regression Therapist must recognise the limitations of the treatment he or she can provide and refer clients to other competent Soul Regression Therapists in appropriate circumstances,
  - (g) a Soul Regression Therapist must recommend to his or her clients that additional opinions and services be sought, where appropriate,
  - (h) a Soul Regression Therapist must assist his or her clients to find other appropriate health care professionals, if required and practicable,
  - (i) a Soul Regression Therapist must encourage his or her clients to inform their treating medical practitioner (if any) of the treatments they are receiving,

- (j) a Soul Regression Therapist must have a sound understanding of any adverse interactions between the therapies and treatments he or she provides or prescribes and any other medications or treatments, whether prescribed or not, that the Soul Regression Therapist is aware the client is taking or receiving,
- (k) a Soul Regression Therapist must ensure that appropriate first aid is available to deal with any misadventure during a client consultation,
- (l) a Soul Regression Therapist must obtain appropriate emergency assistance (for example, from the Ambulance Service) in the event of any serious misadventure during a client consultation.

## **1.2 Soul Regression Therapists diagnosed with infectious medical condition**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist who has been diagnosed with a medical condition that can be passed on to clients must ensure that he or she practises in a manner that does not put clients at risk.
2. Without limiting subclause (1), a Soul Regression Therapist who has been diagnosed with a medical condition that can be passed on to clients should take and follow advice from an appropriate medical practitioner on the steps to be taken to modify his or her practice to avoid the possibility of transmitting that condition to clients.

## **1.3 Soul Regression Therapists not to make claims to cure certain serious illnesses**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not hold himself or herself out as qualified, able or willing to cure cancer and other terminal illnesses.
2. A Soul Regression Therapist may make a claim as to his or her ability or willingness to treat or alleviate the symptoms of those illnesses if that claim can be substantiated.

## **1.4 Appropriate conduct in relation to treatment advice**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not attempt to dissuade clients from seeking or continuing with treatment by a registered medical practitioner.
2. A Soul Regression Therapist must accept the right of his or her clients to make informed choices in relation to their health care.
3. A Soul Regression Therapist should communicate and co-operate with colleagues and other health care practitioners and agencies in the best interests of their clients.

4. A Soul Regression Therapist who has serious concerns about the treatment provided to any of his or her clients by another Soul Regression Therapist must refer the matter to the Health Care Complaints Commission.

### **1.5 Soul Regression Therapists not to practise under influence of alcohol or drugs**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not practise under the influence of alcohol or unlawful drugs.
2. A Soul Regression Therapist who is taking prescribed medication must obtain advice from the prescribing Soul Regression Therapist on the impact of the medication on his or her ability to practice and must refrain from treating clients in circumstances where his or her ability is or may be impaired.

### **1.6 Soul Regression Therapists not to practise with certain physical or mental conditions**

A Soul Regression Therapist must not practise while suffering from a physical or mental impairment, disability, condition or disorder (including an addiction to alcohol or a drug, whether or not pre-scribed) that detrimentally affects, or is likely to detrimentally affect, his or her ability to practise or that places clients at risk of harm.

### **1.7 Soul Regression Therapists not to financially exploit clients**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not accept financial inducements or gifts for referring clients to other Soul Regression Therapists or to the suppliers of medications or therapeutic goods or devices.
2. A Soul Regression Therapist must not offer financial inducements or gifts in return for client referrals from other Soul Regression Therapists.
3. A Soul Regression Therapist must not provide services and treatments to clients unless they are designed to maintain or improve the clients' health or wellbeing.

### **1.8 Soul Regression Therapists required to have clinical basis for treatments**

A Soul Regression Therapist must not diagnose or treat an illness or condition without an adequate clinical basis.

### **1.9 Soul Regression Therapists not to misinform their clients**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not engage in any form of misinformation or misrepresentation in relation to the products or services he or she provides or as to his or her qualifications, training or professional affiliations as defined by all relevant State and Federal legislation.

2. A Soul Regression Therapist must provide truthful information as to his or her qualifications, training or professional affiliations if asked for information about those matters by a client.
3. A Soul Regression Therapist must not make claims, either directly or in advertising or promotional material, about the efficacy of treatment or services provided if those claims cannot be substantiated.

#### **1.10 Soul Regression Therapists not to engage in sexual or improper personal relationship with clients**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must not engage in a sexual or other close personal relationship with a client.
2. Before engaging in a sexual or other close personal relationship with a former client, a Soul Regression Therapist must ensure that a suitable period of time has elapsed since the conclusion of their therapeutic relationship.

#### **1.11 Soul Regression Therapists to comply with relevant privacy laws**

A Soul Regression Therapist must comply with the relevant Country, State, Territory, local or Federal legislation relating to his or her clients' health information.

#### **1.12 Soul Regression Therapists to keep appropriate records**

A Soul Regression Therapist must maintain accurate, legible and contemporaneous clinical records for each client consultation.

#### **1.13 Soul Regression Therapists to keep appropriate insurance**

A Soul Regression Therapist should ensure that appropriate indemnity insurance arrangements are in place in relation to his or her practice.

#### **1.14 Certain Soul Regression Therapists to display code and other information**

1. A Soul Regression Therapist must display a copy of each of the following documents at all premises where the Soul Regression Therapist carries on his or her practice:
  - (a) Their Association's Code of Conduct, (if an association member)
  - (b) A document that gives information about the way in which clients may make a complaint to the relevant complaints authority governing the Soul regression Therapist.
  - (c) Any additional documentation required by Country, State, Territory, local or Federal legislation where the Soul regression Therapist practices Soul Regression Therapy.
